GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The hirer agrees to pay a \$50.00 deposit upfront when hiring trap. Deposit will be refunded on return of the cat trap in good working order. Failure to do so will result in the deposit being forfeited to Naracoorte Lucindale Council.
2. The hirer agrees to pay a charge of \$10.00 per week. Naracoorte Lucindale Council retains the right to collect the cat trap if not returned to the Council office by completion of the loan period.
3. The hirer agrees to set the trap as demonstrated by a Naracoorte Lucindale Council Officer at time of hire.
4. The hirer agrees to notify surrounding neighbours of their trapping activities including the dates and times the trap(s) will be set.
5. The hirer agrees to set the trap in a location that is sheltered from the sun, wind and rain, and agrees to ensure the trap is checked at least every 8 hours from setting.
6. The hirer acknowledges and agrees to abide by the provisions of the Animal Welfare Act 1985 (SA) with respect to the care of cats once trapped. The hirer acknowledges that the person responsible for setting the trap will become responsible for the welfare of **ANY** animal subsequently trapped and may be liable to penalties of \$20,000 or two-year imprisonment if a trapped animal is caused unreasonable harm as a result of an act or omission by the person.
7. The hirer acknowledges and agrees to abide by the provisions of the Dog and Cat Management Act 1995 (SA) with respect to the release of cats that have identification. A cat is taken to be identified if the cat has a collar around its neck and the collar, or a tag securely attached to the collar, is marked with the current address or telephone number of the owner or other person entitled to possession of the cat. The hirer also acknowledges that interfering or removing a cat's identification attracts a penalty of up to \$5,000.

8. The hirer agrees to transport any unidentified trapped cat to the Naracoorte Veterinary Centre, 82 Stewart Terrace Naracoorte, immediately upon becoming aware that the animal has been trapped. The hirer must transport the cat in a manner that is appropriate for the animal's welfare. The cat must not be placed in the boot of a vehicle or other unsuitable place.
9. The hirer accepts that once trapped cats are surrendered to the Naracoorte Veterinary Centre they become the property of the Naracoorte Veterinary Centre to re-home or otherwise dispose of in accordance with its rights and obligations under law.
