



Master Planning

We often use or hear the term Master Plan but what is the purpose or reason for Master Plans?

A Master Plan should guide the future actions of a community. It presents a vision for the future, with long-range goals and objectives.

The plan provides continuity across time by giving successive management bodies (such as Elected Members, staff, community organisations) a common framework for addressing issues.

It is the means by which a community can balance competing interests and protect what it values. It provides guidance for shaping the appearance of the community or a section of the community.

The planning process provides community members with an opportunity to brainstorm, debate and discuss the future of their community or an aspect of their community.

Naracoorte and District Sports Centre

A Master Plan for the Naracoorte and District Sports Centre (Sports Centre) is being prepared. Tredwell, specialist sport, recreation and open space consultants are working with Council on the master plan.

Once completed the Master Plan will:

- Provide direction for the long-term sustainable development and utilisation of the Sports Centre site and facilities, and
- Identify strategies and priorities that address the community needs in relation to the Sports Centre.

How Can You Get Involved?

To support the community to harness the potential for Lucindale to thrive into the future MasterPlan Town and Country Planners and Outerspace Landscape Architects will work with Council and the community to deliver a master plan that is innovative, creative, credible and achievable.

To ensure the plan's success community members are invited to get involved and contribute to the plan.

The Master Plan will address:

- Community buildings and land owned or under the care and control of Council
- Infrastructure - roads, kerb and water table, waste water, drainage, pathways, stormwater, transport
- Public Open Space - parks and gardens, recreation areas and sporting facilities
- Identity and liveability - recognising and identifying the essential character elements of Lucindale, the role and function of Lucindale, streetscape, environmental and social issues
- Planning and development - land supply and demand, identify and consider a range of general land use and development issues
- Business and Tourism - identify future growth and development opportunities
- Provision of services and expected service levels
